3. Mr. Tapan Banik, PGT, Department of Political Science.

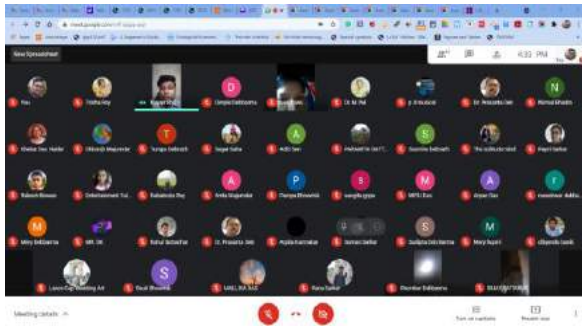

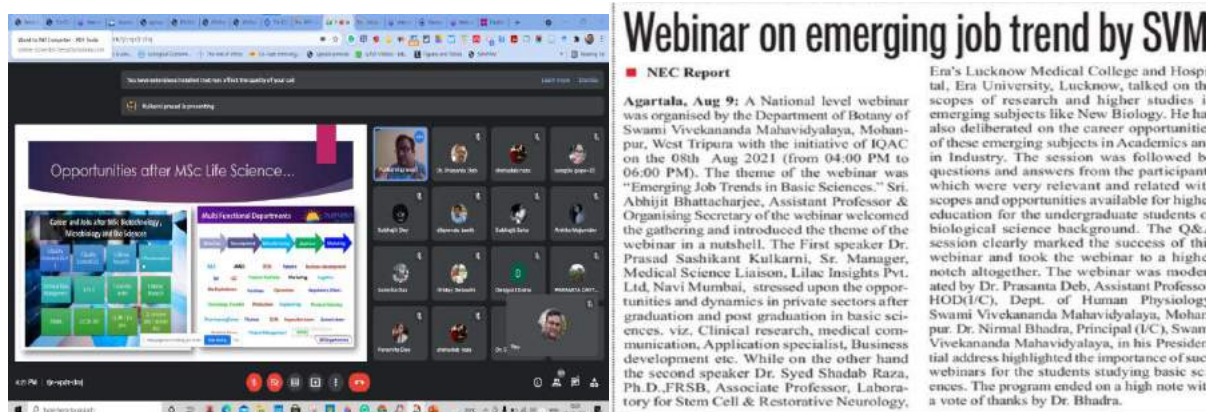
Stem Cell & Restorative Neurology, Era University, Lucknow, talked on the scopes of research, higher studies and career opportunities in emerging subjects.

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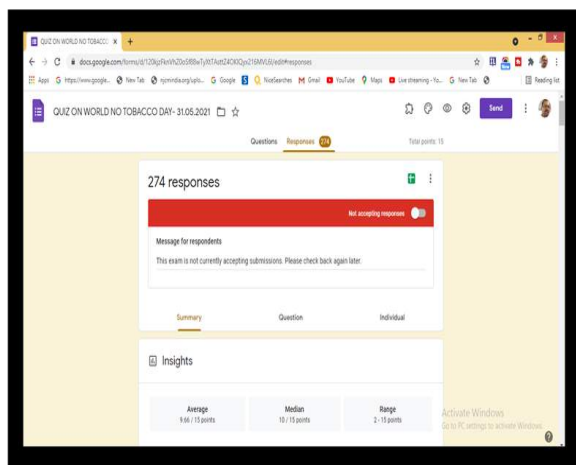
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## 12. World No Tobacco Day-2021

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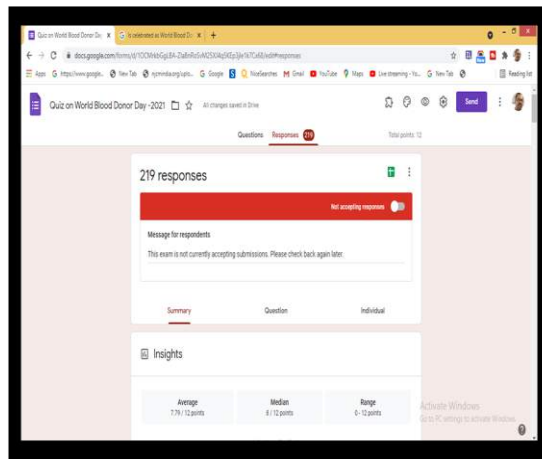
#### **14. World Environment Day- 2021**

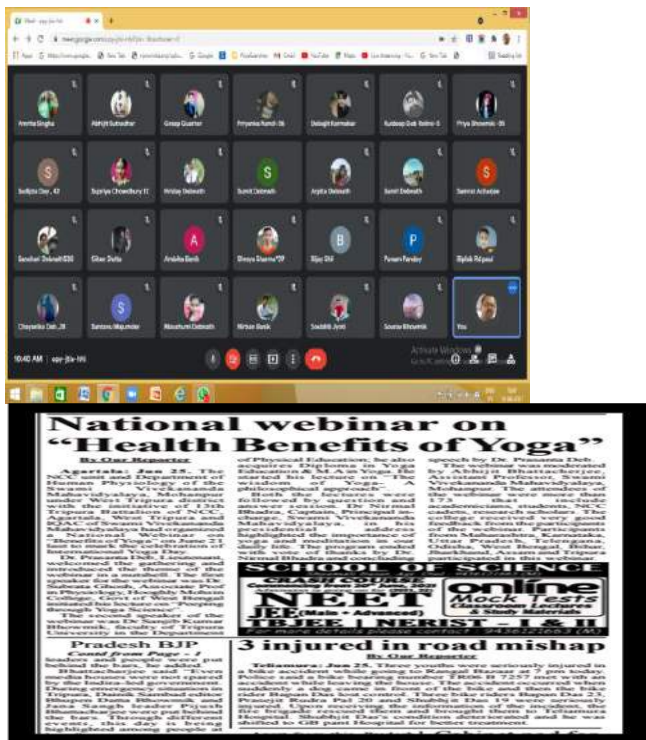

**Report on 10 days programme conducted in the adopted village by NCC Unit of Swami Vivekananda Mahavidyalaya, Mohanpur under 13 Tripura Bn NCC**

The school education in rural Tripura is mostly dependent on Government and Government aided schools. For rural Tripura journey of education is not easy, children from rural areas face many challenges which further exacerbated during this Covid pandemic.

NCC Unit of Swami Vivekananda Mahavidyalaya, Mohanpur had taken the responsibility of educating the poor village students of its adopted Harinakhola village. The unit had initiated a 10 days programme of educating the poor school students residing in the village from 4<sup>th</sup> July, 2021 to 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2021 from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm daily. All the activities were carried out in a room provided by Harinakhola Gram Panchayat, Mohanpur, West Tripura.

The program involved imparting knowledge based on their specified syllabus as well as on various important issues like General Knowledge & Current Affairs, drawings and simple mathematical tricks to solve problems. A total of 19 NCC cadets, Lt. Dr. Prasanta Deb, ANO, and Capt. Dr. Nirmal Bhadhra, Principal-in charge were involved in this practice. Children were given time to spend with each other, play games and interact. A total of 40 students from Class-II to Class-VIII have enrolled in this programme. Everyday two classes were conducted by maintaining the Covid-19 protocols. We found immense enthusiasm and zeal in these students to learn, this was the main driving factor for our cadets to help them in their studies. At the final day, the students were trained to make paper bags using waste papers and old newspapers. NCC cadets also demonstrated the procedure for hand wash.

**Brief Report of the Activities had done by NCC Cadets of Swami Vivekananda Mahavidyalaya, Mohanpur, West Tripura in Different Teams Under “Each One Reach One” Conducted by MGNCRE- Higher Education Institutions.**

**Four teams were created to perform the various activities these includes-**

The cadets were guided to create Whatsapp groups involving their neighbours, nearby relatives and friends to provide the information according to the Teams they selected to perform their work. In various team they perform the following activities-

**TEAM-1 :** Sharing of information on the availability of Beds (ICU, Ventilator). Sharing of information on Covid Testing Centres. Sharing of the Covid Helpline Numbers in Whatsapp groups.

**TEAM-2 :** Sharing of information on the availability of Medical Essentials like Oxygen cylinders, Pulse oximeters, thermometers and medicines. Sharing of information regarding the availability of blood in the blood bank. Sharing of information on Covid Vaccination Centres.

**TEAM-3 :** Communicating with Covid effected on phone. Communicating with Covid effected family members. Sharing information on DIETS, YOGA that are helpful for Covid patients and also various awareness videos.

**TEAM-4 :** Food Distribution by cadets, mask distribution among general public, sharing videos on Yoga and Pranayama, sharing information on Covid Awareness, sharing videos on Covid Awareness, sharing videos on Covid Vaccination, Providing free coaching to the poor children of adopted village.

A total of 504 beneficiaries were incorporated in this drive by our cadets. A total of 16 cadets were involved in these activities. Two ANOs Dr. Prasanta Deb, PSS Faculty Co-ordinator and Dr. Nirmal Bhadra, Principal-in-charge, were actively involved in the practice.
