Special Lecture | Popular Talk

A popular talk was organised by Biotech club of Swami Vivekananda Mahavidyalaya on "Vermicomposting Technology for Sustainable Development". The talk was delivered by the renowned scientist working in the field of Vermicomposting and earthworm technology Prof. Priyasankar Chaudhuri, Department of Eathworm Ecology and Biodiversity, Tripura University on 2nd February, 2019. In this programme Senior Scientific Officer Dr. Anjan Sengupta and two other project officers were also present as representatives of Directorate of Biotechnology, Department of Science and Technology, Government of Tripura.

Admission 2019

Admission process for B.A and B.Sc. was conducted from 26th June to 6th July, 2019. More than 686 forms were distributed and 494 forms were submitted for admission. Till 13th September, 2019, 469 students took admission for the two streams.
