

Subjects offering at Swami Vivekananda Mahavidyalaya during the 2014-15 academic session:

2. Elective Subjects:

2.1. Arts Stream:

Bengali, English, History, Education, Political Science, and Kokborok

2.2. Bio-Science: Botany, Zoology and Physiology

2.3. Subjects with Honours Course:

Bengali, Education, History and Political Science with an intake capacity of 30 students in each of these subjects.

3. Eligibility for admission

3.1. Any student passing H. S. (+2) examination or its equivalent with at least 4 subjects including English from any recognized board/council shall be eligible for admission to the 1st Semester of the B. A. /B.Sc. (Honours/General) programme of studies subject to availability of seats and restriction of combination of subjects in the institution and provided that he/she has secured in that examination, at least,
(a) 40% marks in aggregate and 45% marks in the subject in which he/she seeks Honours.

Or

(b) 35% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in the concerned subject (Group & Course).

(c) There is no any marks bar to determine eligibility for ST/SC students seeking Honours in any subject that has Honours course in the institution.

3.2. Anyone securing at least 50% marks in aggregate shall be eligible for taking Honours in a subject, which he/she did not study in H. S. (+2) examination or its equivalent, subject to restriction of combination of subjects.

3.3. Merit list for admission in a Honours Programme will be prepared by adding the aggregate marks (best of 4 subjects) obtained in the H. S. (+2) examination or its equivalent and the marks of particular subject concerned.

3.4. A student shall not be allowed to take Honours in a subject in which he/she has failed in H. S. (+2) examination or its equivalent but subsequently passed as a compartmental candidate in that subject.

4. A student shall have to apply with 3 copies of recent Passport Size Photo for University Registration in prescribed form. No registration shall be entertained after the expiry of 30 days from date of admission.

5. A student shall be allowed to change a subject (s)/stream within 15 days from his/her admission to the college, subject to the restriction of combination of subjects laid down by the college. No such change shall be allowed once application for University registration is forwarded to the University from the college.

6. No student shall be allowed to prosecute two regular programmes offered by the Tripura University simultaneously.

7. Structures of courses of the programme:

7.1. TDPG and TDPH shall have the following components:

- i. Compulsory (Foundation) Courses
- ii. Honours Courses
- iii. Core (Elective) Courses
- iv. Soft Study Course

The soft study and foundation courses are designed to develop the students' communicative skill and social awareness at the undergraduate level.

7.2. A candidate admitted to General Program (TDPG) shall study Three Core (Elective) Subjects in addition to Foundation Courses. Each core subject will have total 500 marks (i.e. five courses of 100 marks each).

7.3. A student admitted to TDP (Honours) shall study Honours subject of 800 marks (i.e. 8 courses of 100 marks each) along with two core (Elective) subjects of 500 marks each (i.e. five courses of 100 marks each) in addition to Foundation Courses.

7.4. In addition to Core (Elective) subjects, Foundation Courses and Project, a candidate of TDP (General) and TDP (Honours) shall study 3 (three) and 2 (two) soft study courses respectively as would be available in the college.

8. Reservation of seats for ST/SC shall be as per the rules and regulations of the reservation policy of the Government of Tripura.

4. Two attested copies of Madhyamik, Higher Secondary Examinations.
5. One Xerox copy of School Leaving Certificate.

Note (B) :

1. Original School Leaving Certificate shall have to be submitted during admission.
