Day 1 (13.08.2022)

The program came to a close with the distribution of sweets among the students and the local residents.



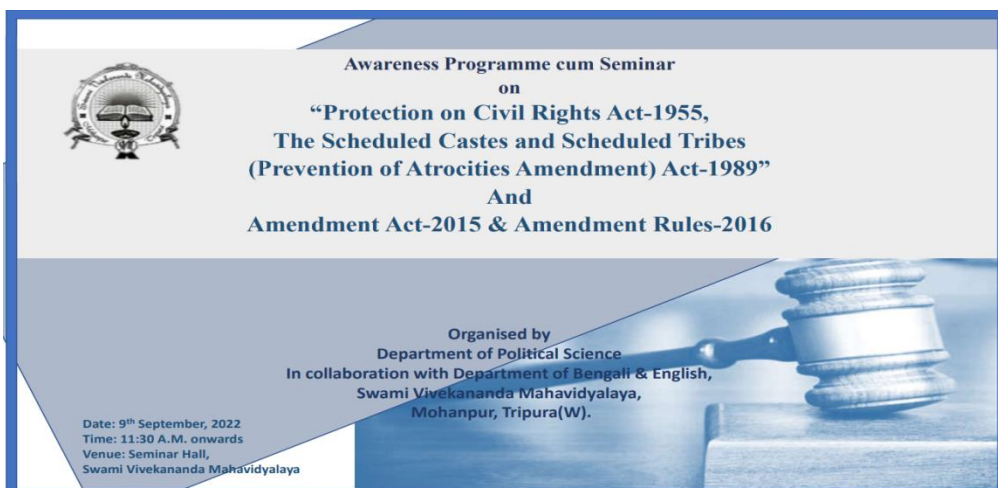
14. Protection on Civil Rights Act 1955 and Protection of Atrocities Act 1989

An awareness programme cum seminar was organized on different provisions of **“Protection on Civil Rights Act-1955, The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities Amendment) Act-1989” and Amendment Act-2015 & Amendment Rules-2016** held on 9th September 2022 from 11:30 AM onwards in Swami Vivekananda Mahavidyalaya, Mohanpur under the Department of Political Science in collaboration with Department of Bengali and English.

The seminar cum awareness programme was inaugurated by the Principal(I/C) of Swami Vivekananda Mahavidyalaya Smt. Anita Majumder. The guests and other dignitaries were welcomed with flower, file cover including writing pad-pen, and risa by the students of the college and welcome speech was delivered by Dr. khelan Das Halder, Convener of the seminar. With the short speech of Mr. Debabrata Roy, Assistant Professor & Secretary Teacher’s Council of SVM regarding the current condition of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes people, the inaugural session ended.

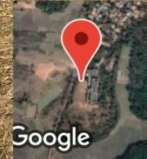
