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Report on "Field Visit on Vermiculture and Vermicomposting"

A total of 25 students along attended this one day field Trip on "Vermiculture and Vermicomposting" at College of Agriculture, Lembucherra, Tripura (W) on 8th November 2023. This field trip was conducted as a part of Skill Enhancement Course (SEC-7: Vermiculture and Vermicomposting) under NEP 2020 syllabus.

In this field trip, Dr. Niladri Paul, Assistant Professor, Department of Soil Science & Agricultural Chemistry, College of Agriculture was the Resource Person.


Dr. Paul demonstrated that the Vermicompost Unit is a well-established facility dedicated to producing high-quality vermicompost for agricultural and gardening purposes. The Unit utilizes a combination of organic waste materials and red worms (*Eisenia fetida*) to produce nutrient-rich compost through the process of vermicomposting. The farm primarily uses a diverse range of organic waste materials including kitchen scraps, agricultural residues, garden waste, and livestock manure. Once the vermicompost is fully matured, it is sieved to remove any large particles and then packaged into bags or bulk containers. The packaging is labeled with essential information such as nutrient content, application guidelines, and batch numbers. The farm distributes its vermicompost to local farmers, gardeners, and nurseries, promoting sustainable agriculture and soil health.

Overall, this field trip to a vermicompost unit provided students with a hands-on opportunity to learn about sustainable waste management practices and the importance of environmental stewardship. It can inspire them to make positive changes in their own lives and communities.




Report on Special Yoga camp at SVM Mohanpur held from 13th June to 16th June 2023 in association with ICFAI University


