Place of visit: Tepania Eco-Park. Udaipur, Dist.: Gomati, Tripura

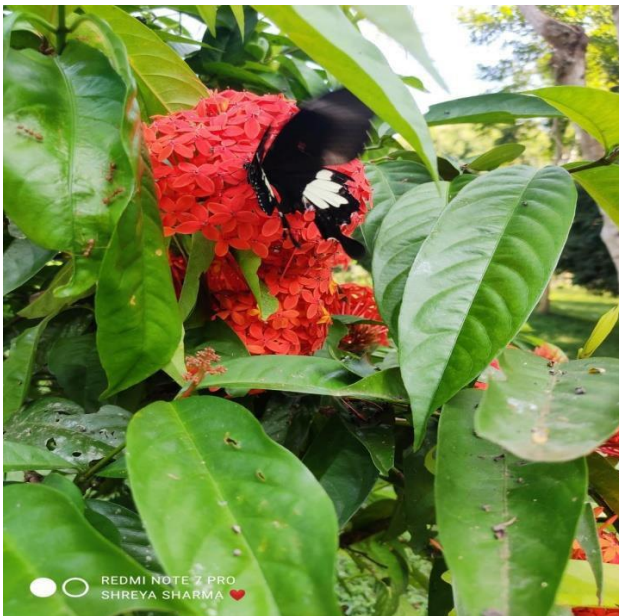

As a part of our courses offered in B.Sc. Zoology Programme of Tripura University, a field trip was arranged for our BSC (Honours) 5th Semester and BSC (General) 3rd Semester Students to Tepania Eco-Park. Udaipur, Dist.: Gomati, Tripura. A total of 48 students participated in this field trip. The trip was planned for one day on 14th November 2022. The students spent nearly three hours and visited several enclosures maintained by the Tepania Ecological Park authority and got exposure to various bio-diversity present in this park. The field trip was planned to experience the field exposure cum practical knowledge pertaining to their in-field understanding of ecology. An Educational Tour Report

Department of Political Science

An Educational Tour of one day was organised by the Department of Political Science, Swami Vivekananda Mahavidyalaya, Mohanpur West Tripura on 23rd December 2022 to visit TTAADC Council Bhawan and TTAADC Museum at Khumulwng TTAADC. The Tour Comprised 40 students of B.A Hons. of 1st, 3rd and 5th Semester accompanied by Faculty members Bina Rani Tripura, Rojina Debbarma, Subhash Debnath and Dr. Manas Das. All the Students were directed to gather at College Gate at 9.30am. The tour started at 10 o'clock from the College campus and reached the destination at 12 noon. After reaching the destination the students first visited the Council Bhawan of TTAADC. One of the staff of the Council Bhawan guided the students about the functioning of the council. He showed them the sitting arrangement of the Chairman, various council members, press members and the public. He also showed the video recording facility of the Council work.

The students then visited the Museum of TTAADC where they saw the life style of various tribes of Tripura. The students studied various artifacts including cloths, hunting materials, ornaments, daily use materials. The students return back to the college at 5pm. The visit was over all successful as the students gained first-hand knowledge about the functioning of TTAADC and had the opportunity to correlate with theoretical knowledge. The students also learn about the life style of Tribal people.
